

Arizona Homeschool Graduation Requirements

At a glance · facts last reviewed August 28, 2026

State notification	Notarized affidavit of intent to the county school superintendent within 30 days; one time, not annual
Legal basis	Homeschool defined as a nonpublic school under Arizona Revised Statutes 15-802
Required subjects	Reading, grammar, mathematics, social studies, and science
Testing / evaluation	None. Section 15-745 bars required testing of children while they are homeschooled
Graduation requirements	None set by the state; the parent decides when the program is complete
Who issues the diploma	The parent, in the name of the family's homeschool, signed as the program's administrator
Diploma recognition	ARS 1-701 makes every governmental entity in the state treat the diploma like any other
College admissions	ASU and U of A admit on a parent-signed transcript listing each course with its credit and grade
Compulsory attendance ages	6 to 16 (ARS 15-802)
