

Arkansas Homeschool Graduation Requirements

State notification	Notice of Intent to the resident district superintendent, filed June 15 to August 15 (6-15-503)
Legal basis	Arkansas Code 6-15-501 through 6-15-509; no educational qualifications imposed on the parent
Required subjects	None. Arkansas does not regulate homeschool curriculum or monitor student work
Testing / evaluation	None. Act 832 of 2015 repealed the testing mandate; a state-funded PSAT or ACT is optional
Recordkeeping	No records required or reviewed; the state suggests attendance, a portfolio, grades, and a transcript
Graduation requirements	None set by the state; the parent determines completion
Who issues the diploma	The parent, in the name of the family's home school; no district or state office issues one
College admissions	University of Arkansas reviews homeschool applicants by the same standards as all new freshmen
Compulsory attendance ages	5 (turning five on or before August 1) to at least 17
