

Delaware Homeschool Graduation Requirements

State notification	Register the homeschool as a nonpublic school in the Department of Education's online NPS system
Legal basis	14 Delaware Code 2703A, which treats homeschools as nonpublic schools
Homeschool categories	Single-family, multi-family, or single-family coordinated with the district using approved curriculum
Annual filings	Enrollment statement by September 30 and end-of-year attendance report by July 31 (14 Del. C. 2704)
Testing / evaluation	None. No standardized testing, progress reports, work samples, or subject checklist
Graduation requirements	None set by the state; the parent decides when the program is complete
Who issues the diploma	The parent, in the name of the registered nonpublic school, signed as administrator
College admissions	Delaware homeschoolers self-report coursework through UD's STARS, then submit a final transcript
Compulsory attendance ages	5 to 16 (14 Delaware Code 2702)
