

Florida Homeschool Graduation Requirements

At a glance · facts last reviewed August 28, 2026

State notification	Notice of intent to the district superintendent within 30 days, plus a termination notice at the end
Legal basis	Home education program under Florida Statute 1002.41, or enrollment in a private umbrella school
Recordkeeping	Portfolio of an activity log and work samples, kept two years, inspectable on 15 days written notice
Annual evaluation	Filed each year, choosing among five statutory options including a certified teacher portfolio review
Graduation requirements	None prescribed; the parent decides when the family's requirements are complete
Who issues the diploma	The parent, in the name of the home education program; umbrella school students receive the school's
College admissions	State universities and Florida College System institutions admit home education graduates (1002.41)
State scholarships	Bright Futures needs district registration in grades 11 and 12; test scores only, no transcript or GPA
