

Hawaii Homeschool Graduation Requirements

At a glance · facts last reviewed August 28, 2026

State notification	Form 4140 or a letter of intent to the principal of the assigned public school. No approval step
Legal basis	Hawaii Administrative Rules Title 8, Chapter 12, the compulsory attendance exceptions chapter
Required subjects	None prescribed. Curriculum is never submitted for approval, only recorded by the parent
Testing / evaluation	Standardized testing in grades 3, 5, 8, and 10, plus an annual progress report to the principal
Recordkeeping	Program dates, weekly hours, subject areas, methods of determining mastery, and materials used
Graduation requirements	None for home programs. A state DOE diploma requires three full years in a public high school
Who issues the diploma	The parent, in the name of the family's program, signed as administrator
College admissions	UH Manoa takes a self-reported application plus a qualifying ACT, SAT, GED, HiSET, or TASC score
