

Indiana Homeschool Graduation Requirements

At a glance · facts last reviewed August 28, 2026

State notification	None required. IDOE's online enrollment report is optional and creates no ongoing obligations
Legal basis	Indiana Code 20-33-2-28, requiring only instruction equivalent to that given in public schools
Required subjects	None prescribed. State law does not define equivalency for nonpublic, non-accredited schools
Recordkeeping	180 instructional days a year and attendance records, produced only on request (20-33-2-20)
Testing / evaluation	None. Indiana requires no state testing or any other testing of homeschooled children
Graduation requirements	None for nonpublic, non-accredited schools; the parent decides. Core 40 is the practical reference
Who issues the diploma	The parent, in the family's school name. Neither IDOE nor the local public school will issue one
College admissions	Purdue Fort Wayne expects Core 40 or Academic Honors coursework and rejects handwritten transcripts
Compulsory attendance ages	From the fall term of the year the child turns 7 until graduation or age 18
