

Mississippi Homeschool Graduation Requirements

At a glance · facts last reviewed August 28, 2026

State notification	A certificate of enrollment filed with the local school attendance officer on or before September 15 each year
Legal basis	Home instruction is a nonpublic school under Mississippi Code 37-13-91, with no state authority over curriculum
Required subjects	None. Mississippi sets no required subjects and no minimum instructional days or hours
Testing / evaluation	None. No testing, portfolio, annual report, or attendance submission is required
Recordkeeping	Keep each year's certificate as proof of filing, plus a signed transcript for grades nine through twelve
Graduation requirements	None. The parent decides completion; the 24-unit public traditional diploma is a reference point only
Who issues the diploma	The parent, in the name of the family's program, signed by the parent as administrator
College admissions	Public universities accept home school transcripts or a portfolio, plus ACT or SAT scores and GPA
State aid	MTAG and MESG accept a signed parent transcript for grades nine through twelve in place of a GPA
