

Nevada Homeschool Graduation Requirements

At a glance · facts last reviewed August 28, 2026

State notification	One notice of intent per child, filed once with the resident district superintendent; no annual renewal
Legal basis	NRS 388D.010 through 388D.070, with the compulsory attendance exemption in NRS 392.070
Required subjects	Educational plan in English language arts, mathematics, science, and social studies (NRS 388D.050)
Testing / evaluation	None. No testing, minimum hours, attendance logs, or progress reports are required
Recordkeeping	Keep the district's written acknowledgment permanently; it is deemed proof of compliance
Graduation requirements	None. The parent sets the course of study and decides when it is complete
Who issues the diploma	The parent, in the name of the family's program; Nevada issues no state completion credential
College admissions	NRS 388D.040 bars any school or organization from discriminating against a homeschooled child
