

New Hampshire Homeschool Graduation Requirements

At a glance · facts last reviewed August 28, 2026

State notification	One time per child, within 5 business days, to the commissioner, superintendent, or nonpublic principal
Legal basis	Home education under RSA chapter 193-A; RSA 193-A:11 bars districts from more restrictive policies
Required subjects	Science, math, language, government, history, health, reading, writing, spelling, art, and music
Recordkeeping	Portfolio of a reading log and work samples, the parent's property, kept 2 years after instruction ends
Annual assessment	Portfolio review, a national achievement test, or the state test; kept by the parent, not filed
Graduation requirements	None prescribed. The parent decides what constitutes completion and builds the transcript
Who issues the diploma	The parent directing the program; RSA 193-A provides for no state or district diploma
College admissions	UNH applies the same admissions criteria to homeschooled students as to other applicants
Ages covered	RSA 193-A applies to children at least 6 and under 18
