

Ohio Homeschool Graduation Requirements

At a glance · facts last reviewed August 28, 2026

State notification	Notice to the resident district superintendent within five days of starting, then by August 30 yearly
Legal basis	Home education under Ohio Revised Code 3321.042, effective October 3, 2023
Required subjects	English language arts, mathematics, science, history, government, and social studies
Testing / evaluation	None. The statute has no testing, portfolio, or minimum hours requirement
Recordkeeping	Nothing is filed after the notice; keep the superintendent's written acknowledgment each year
Graduation requirements	None set by the state; the parent defines the high school curriculum (ORC 3313.6110)
Who issues the diploma	The parent or person having charge of the child, under ORC 3313.6110
Diploma recognition	Statute makes the parent-granted diploma proof of completion for any legal requirement
College admissions	Ohio public universities admit home educated graduates on the parent transcript and diploma
