

Oregon Homeschool Graduation Requirements

At a glance · facts last reviewed August 28, 2026

State notification	Written notice to the regional Education Service District within 10 days; no annual renewal
Legal basis	Compulsory attendance exemption under ORS 339.030, with operating rules in ORS 339.035
Testing / evaluation	Nationally normed test at the end of grades 3, 5, 8, and 10, given by a qualified neutral person
Recordkeeping	Test results go to the parent and are submitted to the ESD only on request
Graduation requirements	None set by the state; the parent determines when the program is complete
Who issues the diploma	The parent, in the name of the family's program; no Oregon agency certifies homeschool graduation
College admissions	Oregon Promise accepts the ESD letter, a grade 10 test result, and the home-school transcript
Compulsory attendance ages	6, reached by September 1, through 18
