

Texas Homeschool Graduation Requirements

State notification	None. No agency registers, approves, or oversees a Texas homeschool
Legal basis	Private school under Texas Education Code 25.086 and TEA v. Leeper (Tex. 1994)
Required subjects	Reading, spelling, grammar, mathematics, and good citizenship, in a bona fide written curriculum
Testing / evaluation	None required by the state
Graduation requirements	Set by the parent as administrator; the state imposes none
Who issues the diploma	The parent, in the name of the family's homeschool program
College admissions	Public universities must treat homeschool graduates like other applicants (TEC 51.9241)
Compulsory attendance ages	6 to 19
