

Utah Homeschool Graduation Requirements

At a glance · facts last reviewed August 28, 2026

State notification	One-time notice to the local school board, which acknowledges receipt within 30 days; no renewal
Legal basis	School attendance exemption under Utah Code 53G-6-204, amended by HB 209 (2025)
Required subjects	None prescribed; the parent selects materials, time, place, and method of instruction
Testing / evaluation	A school board may not require standardized or other testing of home school students
Recordkeeping	A board may not require records of instruction or attendance, credentials, or home inspection
Graduation requirements	None set by the state; the parent determines when the student has completed high school
Who issues the diploma	The parent; neither the district nor the State Board issues a homeschool credential
College admissions	UVU admits on a notarized Affidavit of Completion of Homeschool, with no GED required
