

Wyoming Homeschool Graduation Requirements

State notification	None since July 1, 2025. The Homeschool Freedom Act ended annual curriculum filing
Legal basis	Home-based program counts as a private school under Wyo. Stat. 21-4-101 and 21-4-102
Required subjects	Sequentially progressive reading, writing, mathematics, civics, history, literature, and science
Testing / evaluation	None required, and no records are filed with the district or the state
Public school withdrawal	In-person meeting with a district counselor plus written consent (21-4-102(c))
Graduation requirements	None set by the state; the parent administering the program decides when it is complete
Who issues the diploma	The parent, in the name of the family's program; no agency certifies completion
College admissions	UW asks for a Home School Credit Evaluation form; Hathaway sets eligibility by test score, not GPA
Compulsory attendance ages	7, birthday on or before August 1, to 16 or completion of tenth grade
